INTRODUCTION

Brethren, I beseech you to embrace the gift and privilege of prayer, which has been graciously bestowed upon us. This divine tool is given to all, that we might wield the great power it offers. Yet, it is lamentable that many believers exercise this power but faintly. As the Apostle Paul urged the early church, "**Pray without ceasing**" (1 Thessalonians 5:17), so must we elevate the fervency of our prayers if we are to witness significant breakthroughs.

The prayer points in this book are meticulously targeted at specific needs, that you may not be as one beating the air (1 Corinthians 9:26). Use this book thus:

- 1. Identify your need by consulting the table of contents.
- 2. Select the scriptures that promise what you seek. Meditate upon them, allowing them to saturate your spirit.
- 3. Engage in prayer by one of the following methods, as led by the Holy Spirit:
- Three nights of vigil, praying from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- A three-day fast, breaking daily at 6:00 or 9:00 p.m.
- Seven nights of vigil, praying from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- A seven-day fast, breaking daily at 6:00 or 9:00 p.m.
- A three or more days' dry fast, praying without food or drink.
- 4. Pray with fervency and aggression.

Remember the exhortation: *"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit"* (Ephesians 6:18). To pray in the Spirit, one must be baptized in the Holy Ghost. I am confident that as you do these things, you will be victorious in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Beloved brethren, it is imperative to understand that the demonstration of God's power is often preceded by confrontation with the adversary. As Paul the Apostle admonished Timothy, *"Fight the good fight of faith*" (1 Timothy 6:12), so must we engage in the ministry of conflict. It is a grievous error of this age that many have neglected this essential ministry, choosing instead the path of least resistance. We, who are called to be soldiers of Christ, must forsake the comforts of complacency and prepare ourselves for spiritual warfare.

There can be no victory without conflict, no conquest without warfare. The pathway of conflict is the only route that leads to the city of victory. As Paul wrote, "We wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places" (Ephesians 6:12). To attain the conqueror's crown, we must engage in this spiritual struggle. If we shirk from this duty, the enemy will not hesitate to attack us. Hence, we must exercise our authority in Christ, lest the devil exercise his over us.

The era of complacency is over. From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force (Matthew 11:12). We are in an era of conflict, and our adversary, the devil, cannot be appeased or ignored. He only understands the language of violence and resounding defeat. Therefore, take up the whole armor of God, and fight until every foe is vanquished and Christ is Lord indeed.

The ministry of conflict is indispensable for every believer, especially in these last days. It is through conflict that we achieve victory over the battles of life. The scripture declares, "They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. But the Lord is my defense; and my God is the rock of my refuge. And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the Lord our God shall cut them off" (Psalm 94:21-23). Life is a battlefield, and all men, regardless of their disposition, must face battles. These battles may arise early in life, in middle age, or in old age. Your personal history may be fraught with struggles, but know this: until you grasp the ministry of conflict, you will continue to suffer.

Many seek solutions from various sources, only to find temporary relief. True deliverance and victory come from understanding and engaging in spiritual warfare. Recognize that the devil exploits any weakness or slackness in your spiritual life. He attacks not only through physical means but also in the realm of dreams, where many suffer demonic harassment. Sleeplessness and nightmares are often the work of wicked spirits.

Persistent problems often have deep, unknown roots. Until these roots are exposed and addressed through spiritual conflict, they will remain. The story of the woman who suffered mental disturbances when her house was well-stocked with food illustrates this truth. Her deliverance came only when the root of her problem, a demonic spirit invited during her infancy, was identified and confronted.

The ministry of conflict is essential for tackling deeply rooted spiritual issues. Evil spirits can lurk in obscurity for decades, waiting for the opportune moment to strike. Through aggressive warfare prayers, these hidden enemies are challenged and expelled. Spiritual warfare targets the powers of darkness, not individuals. To wage effective spiritual warfare, you must discern your enemy and understand the nature of your conflict.

Identify whether the problem is a natural malfunction, a curse, a demonic possession, or a result of household enemies. Once identified, apply the principles of spiritual conflict: repentance, discernment, persistence, and holy violence. Remember, "The weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds" (2 Corinthians 10:4).

Repentance is the first step, as unrepentant sin grants the enemy legal ground in your life.

Genuine, complete repentance disarms the enemy. Next, discern the nature of the enemy you face. Persistence in prayer is crucial, as longstanding demonic strongholds often require prolonged spiritual assault to be demolished.

Violent prayers, though they may seem strange, are effective. Commands for angels to bind, confuse, and pursue demonic forces weaken and drive them away. Engage in the ministry of conflict with fervor, using warfare scriptures and prayer points to attack your spiritual enemies relentlessly.

Beloved, begin this ministry of conflict today. As you do, bondage will break, yokes will be destroyed, and long-standing problems will vanish. Engage in this holy warfare with confidence, knowing that you will have the last laugh against the devil. Amen.

THE PATH TO DELIVERANCE

Brethren, there are three principal ways by which believers can be delivered from bondage and the influence of any spirit that is not of God.

First, we must become mature in Christ. As we grow in our faith and become more fervent in our devotion, we experience a level of automatic deliverance. The scripture teaches us, "But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 3:18). As we become more consumed by the fire of the Holy Spirit, certain spirits will find our lives too hot to inhabit. Their presence will be driven away by the sanctifying power of our spiritual maturity.

Second, we must know the truth, for it is the truth that sets us free (John 8:32). Immerse yourself in the Word of God—read it, study it, memorize it. The Word of God is our sword, our defense against the wiles of the enemy. When we know our authority in Christ and claim the promises of God, deliverance follows. "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom" (Colossians 3:16). However, if these first two methods do not suffice, there is yet a third way.

The ministry of conflict is our third means of deliverance. This ministry involves the declaration of war against the powers of darkness. We must contend earnestly for what has been captured by the enemy. As the Apostle Paul exhorts, *"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places"* (Ephesians 6:12). Satan is a thief who must be prosecuted. To succeed, we must understand his tactics, identify the entry points he uses, and shut them.

Consider the man who was relentlessly harassed by thieves. He devised a clever method to catch them by having them sweep around his house until daybreak, then handed them over to the authorities. Likewise, we must employ spiritual strategies to confront and expel the enemy from our lives.

Recognize that demons understand their rights and will exploit any unrepentant sin or unresolved issue in our lives to maintain their hold.

It is a fallacy to believe that all problems disappear upon being born again. Salvation equips us for battle, but it does not exempt us from conflict. It is a step towards using the authority of Jesus Christ to fight and win our battles. We must attack wicked problems from their roots, striving not for partial victories but for total deliverance.

Pathways to Spiritual Bondage

Several factors can lead believers into bondage. These include:

- 1. Not living in God's will: Sin opens the door to demonic attacks.
- 2. **Inherited curses:** Generational curses can bind individuals until they are broken through prayer.
- 3. **Emotional trauma:** Psychological wounds can invite spiritual oppression.
- 4. **Submission to ungodly influences:** Staying under an evil umbrella leads to bondage.
- 5. Worldliness: Love for the world invites satanic influence.
- 6. **Ownership of demonic objects:** Keeping such items can bind individuals to evil.
- 7. Failure to cleanse property and environment: Spiritual contamination can invite problems.
- 8. Not honouring the Lord with your Finances: This disobedience opens doors to devourers.
- 9. Lack of forgiveness: Unforgiveness grants the enemy access to our lives.
- 10. Lack of separation from the world: Non-separation invites demonic influence.

Keys to Spiritual Warfare Ministry

To engage effectively in the ministry of conflict, follow these steps:

- 1. **Repentance:** Genuine repentance is crucial. Unconfessed sin gives the enemy legal rights over your life. *"Repent therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out"* (Acts 3:19).
- 2. Discernment: Identify the enemy and understand the nature of your conflict. "For we are not ignorant of his devices" (2 Corinthians 2:11).
- 3. **Persistence:** Persistent prayer is needed to dismantle longstanding demonic structures. *"Pray without ceasing"* (1 Thessalonians 5:17).
- 4. Violence: Use the forceful, authoritative prayers to confront and disarm the enemy. "The kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force" (Matthew 11:12).

Brethren, engage in this holy warfare with the full armor of God, confident that through persistent and fervent prayer, we will see the victory and deliverance that is ours in Christ Jesus. Amen.

Prayer Points

Beloved, as we engage in the ministry of prayer, let us approach the throne of grace with boldness and confidence, knowing that our God hears and answers our petitions. Let us fervently lift our voices, trusting in the power of our Lord Jesus Christ to deliver us from all forms of bondage and affliction. Pray without ceasing, for the effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much (James 5:16).

1. Freedom from Womb Problems:

• Father, in the name of Jesus, I set myself free from all problems originating from the womb. Deliver me from every inherited bondage and affliction.

2. Release from Strongmen:

• Every strongman assigned to any area of my life, be driven out now in the name of Jesus. Release your hold and flee from me.

3. Invocation of Divine Power:

• Power of God, descend upon me mightily, in the name of Jesus. Manifest Your strength in my life and circumstances.

4. Break Satanic Bondage:

• I break free from every satanic bondage and dark place, in the name of Jesus. Let every chain be shattered and every yoke be destroyed.

5. Restoration of Stolen Property:

• You spiritual thieves, return my stolen property, in the name of Jesus. What the enemy has taken from me, let it be restored sevenfold.

6. Revelation of Hidden Secrets:

• Lord, reveal unto me any secrets behind my problems that I do not know, in the name of Jesus. Unveil the hidden roots of my afflictions and give me wisdom to address them.

Let us approach each prayer point with the understanding that we are wrestling not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, and spiritual wickedness in high places (Ephesians 6:12). Pray with authority and conviction, and may the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Amen.

THE DYNAMICS OF SPIRITUAL WARFARE

Beloved brethren, as we consider the message entitled "The Science of Spiritual Violence," let us turn our hearts and minds to the scriptures. Our Lord Jesus Christ declared, "And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force" (Matthew 11:12). This profound statement calls us to a life of holy aggression in our spiritual endeavors.

We are also reminded by our Lord's words, "This kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting" (Matthew 17:21). This reveals that certain spiritual challenges require more than prayer alone; they necessitate the added discipline of fasting. Furthermore, the Lord commended the unjust steward for his shrewdness, saying, "For the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light" (Luke 16:8). From these scriptures, we see a common theme of urgency, determination, and spiritual aggression.

Holy violence is essential for attaining the place God has destined for us. You may ask, why is such aggression necessary? Isaiah proclaims, *"To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house"*(Isaiah 42:7). This underscores that there are captives held under the watch of prison warders who resist their release. To free them, we must engage in holy violence.

Our Lord further states, "Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man?" (Matthew 12:29). This implies that to reclaim what the enemy has stolen, we must first confront and bind the adversary.

I recall the testimony of a young man called Sunday, whom the Lord called to minister in a village steeped in demonic practices. Despite initial resistance, through persistent and violent prayer, he witnessed the scattering of demonic gatherings and the eventual transformation of the village. This illustrates that spiritual violence is not merely defensive but proactive, taking the battle into the enemy's camp.

Brethren, let us remember that the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds (2 Corinthians 10:4). The Bible is replete with accounts of spiritual warfare, filled with battles, weapons, and victories achieved through divine power.

Jesus's Mission

Our Lord Jesus came to accomplish three main objectives:

- 1. Salvation: He came to seek and to save the lost.
- 2. **Healing:** He came to heal the brokenhearted and those oppressed by sickness.
- 3. **Deliverance:** He came to set the captives free.

Deliverance is a crucial aspect of our spiritual journey. It involves spiritual warfare to break free from any form of bondage. Let us explore how deliverance can be obtained:

- 6. **Aggressive Challenge:** Boldly confront the enemy with the authority of God's Word.
- 7. **Holy Living:** Maintain a life of holiness, for unrighteousness weakens your spiritual authority.

Strategies of Spiritual Warfare

When engaging in spiritual warfare, follow these strategies:

- 1. **Identify the Enemy:** Clearly discern the nature of the spiritual forces you are confronting.
- 2. Eliminate Fear: Approach the battle with confidence, knowing that God is with you.
- 3. **Declare War:** Use the Word of God, prayer, and fasting to wage war against your spiritual adversaries.

Beloved, let us take up the full armor of God and engage in this holy conflict with unwavering determination. May the God of peace soon crush Satan under our feet. Amen. Beloved brethren, let us contemplate the divine mission of our Lord Jesus Christ, who came into this world to fulfill three paramount purposes:

- 1. Salvation: Jesus came to seek and to save that which was lost. As it is written, "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost" (Luke 19:10). This is the very essence of His ministry, to deliver us from the bondage of sin and death, bringing us into the glorious light of the Kingdom of God.
- 2. Healing: Our Lord came to heal the brokenhearted and to restore those afflicted by sickness and infirmity. The prophet Isaiah spoke of Him, "Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows...and with his stripes we are healed" (Isaiah 53:4-5). Jesus' ministry was marked by countless acts of healing, demonstrating His compassion and the power of God to make whole.
- 3. Deliverance: Jesus came to set the captives free. - 4. Personal Effort: Perhaps the most challenging, yet the most effective, is personal effort in prayer and fasting. As we personally engage in fervent, effectual prayer, we secure our deliverance. "Pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). The tragedy of modern Christianity is the prevalence of prayerless believers. True deliverance is often secured through personal intercession and spiritual discipline.

Brethren, let us embrace the fullness of the ministry of Jesus. As we seek salvation, healing, and deliverance, may we do so with the fervor and dedication exemplified by our Lord. Engage in the ministry of conflict with faith and perseverance, and let us witness the mighty works of God in our lives. Amen.

THE LAWS OF SPIRITUAL VIOLENCE

Brethren, as we delve into the principles governing spiritual violence, let us remember the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, who taught us that the kingdom of heaven suffers violence, and the violent take it by force (Matthew 11:12). Spiritual warfare requires us to be both strategic and resolute. Here are the key laws we must adhere to in this holy endeavor:

1. Purposeful Warfare:

• Engage in battle with a clear and defined purpose. As Paul wrote, "I therefore so run, not as uncertainly: so fight I, not as one that beateth the air" (1 Corinthians 9:26). Identify the specific blessings or breakthroughs you seek to reclaim from the enemy. Whether it is your health, marriage, finances, or spiritual growth, make your objective clear before the Lord.

2. Proper Instructions:

- Be guided by divine wisdom and instruction. "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally" (James 1:5). Prepare yourself spiritually, sometimes through fasting, to receive and act upon God's guidance. Do not enter into battle unprepared or ill-informed.
- 3. Thorough Self-Examination:
- Examine your life to ensure there are no open doors for the enemy. *"Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith"* (2 Corinthians 13:5). Confess and forsake all known sins, as unrighteousness gives the enemy a foothold. Purity and holiness are critical in spiritual warfare.

4. Adequate Preparation:

• Equip yourself fully for the spiritual battle ahead. "Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil" (Ephesians 6:11). This preparation may involve periods of fasting, intensive prayer, and immersing yourself in the Word of God.

- Confront the enemy boldly with the authority of God's Word. "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (James 4:7). Declare war against the spiritual forces arrayed against you, using scripture as your weapon.
- 7. Holy Living:
- Maintain a life of holiness, for *"without holiness no man shall see the Lord"* (Hebrews 12:14). Any form of unrighteousness will render you powerless in the face of spiritual adversaries. Live righteously and let your life be a testament to the transformative power of God's grace.

Tactics Of Spiritual Warfare

Brethren, when engaging in spiritual warfare, employ the following strategies:

- 1. Identify the Enemy:
- Clearly discern what or who you are fighting against. *"For we are not ignorant of his devices"* (2 Corinthians 2:11). Recognize the spiritual roots of your challenges, be they demonic oppression, curses, or strongholds.
- 2. Eliminate Fear:

Let us stand firm in our faith, equipped with the full armor of God, and engage in spiritual violence with the assurance of victory through Christ Jesus. Amen.

Prayer Points

Beloved brethren, as we come before the throne of grace, let us lift our voices with boldness and confidence, trusting in the power of our Lord Jesus Christ to deliver us from every bondage and affliction. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much (James 5:16). Therefore, let us pray with earnest hearts, knowing that our God hears and answers.

- 1. Freedom from Womb Problems:
- Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus, I declare myself free from all problems emanating from the womb. Deliver me from every inherited bondage and affliction.
- 2. Release from Strongmen:
- Every strongman attached to any area of my life, be driven out now in the name of Jesus. Release your hold and depart from me.
- 3. Invocation of Divine Power:
- Almighty God, let Your power descend mightily upon me, in the name of Jesus. Manifest Your strength in my life and circumstances.

4. Break Satanic Bondage:

• I break free from every satanic bondage and dark place, in the name of Jesus. Let every chain be shattered and every yoke be destroyed.

5. Restoration of Stolen Property:

- You spiritual thieves, release my property now, in the name of Jesus. What the enemy has taken from me, let it be restored sevenfold.

6. Revelation of Hidden Secrets:

- Lord, reveal unto me any secrets behind my problems that I do not know, in the name of Jesus. Unveil the hidden roots of my afflictions and grant me wisdom to address them.

Brethren, let us pray with the understanding that we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places (Ephesians 6:12). Pray with authority and conviction, and may the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Amen.

LORD, WITNESS THEIR THREATS

Beloved brethren, as we reflect on the words of the apostles in Acts 4, let us draw strength and courage from their example. When faced with threats and opposition, they lifted their voices to God and prayed, "And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word" (Acts 4:29). Let us, too, approach our challenges with this same boldness and faith.

Consider the prayer of Moses when Korah, Dathan, and Abiram rebelled against the Lord. Moses prayed, "If these men die the common death of all men, or if they be visited after the visitation of all men; then the Lord hath not sent me. But if the Lord make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then ye shall understand that these men have provoked the Lord" (Numbers 16:29-30). Immediately, the ground opened and swallowed them, demonstrating God's swift judgment and vindication.

Similarly, when Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal, he prayed, "Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word. Hear me, O Lord, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the Lord God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again"(1 Kings 18:36-37). Fire fell from heaven, consuming the sacrifice and turning the hearts of the people back to God.

And in Acts 4, the apostles, after being threatened and commanded not to speak in the name of Jesus, prayed with one accord, "Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is... And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, by stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus" (Acts 4:24, 29-30). The place where they prayed was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, speaking the word of God with boldness.

Characteristics of Effective Prayer

From these examples, we can discern several key characteristics of effective prayer:

- 1. Petition Before God:
- Present your cause before the Lord, laying out your case as if He did not already know. "Plead your cause, O Lord, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me" (Psalm 35:1).
- 2. Reporting the Enemy's Threats:
- Bring the threats and schemes of the enemy before God. "Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?" (Psalm 2:1). Speak to God as a friend, sharing your concerns and seeking His intervention.
- 3. Declaration of War:
- Declare war against the opposing forces, asking for God's immediate intervention. *"The Lord is a man of war: the Lord is his name"* (Exodus 15:3).
- 4. Instant Divine Intervention:
- Request urgent and immediate action from God. Even if the answer does not come immediately in tangible form, trust that God has heard and will act. "And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them?" (Luke 18:7).
- 5. Heartfelt and Fervent Prayer:
- Pray from the depths of your heart. Surface-level prayers will not suffice in times of great need. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16).

- 6. Faith and Expectancy:
- Pray with faith, believing that God will act. "But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering" (James 1:6). Expect God to move on your behalf.
- 7. Divine Dissatisfaction:
- Be divinely dissatisfied with your current situation and pray with a holy urgency for change. *"Woe to them that are at ease in Zion" (*Amos 6:1).

8. Request for Divine Judgment:

- Ask God to judge the opposition according to His righteousness. "Let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just" (Psalm 7:9).
- 9. Call for Supernatural Manifestation:
- Request that God displays His power through signs and wonders. "These signs shall follow them that believe" (Mark 16:17).

10. Expressly Seek Signs and Wonders:

• Pray specifically for God to show His power through miracles. "And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following" (Mark 16:20).

Example Prayer Points

Reflecting on these principles, let us pray with the following points:

- 1. Let God Be Glorified:
- Lord, let it be known that You are God in my life and in every situation I face.
- 2. Divine Intervention:
- Lord, do a new thing to my enemies that will permanently destroy their power. Let the earth open and swallow every stubborn pursuer.

3. Manifestation of God's Power:

• Lord God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, manifest Yourself in Your power in my circumstances.

4. Answered by Fire:

• God of Elijah, answer my prayers by fire. Let every power challenging Your authority in my life be disgraced now.

5. Frustration of Enemy Plans:

• Every evil plan against me, be rendered impotent in the name of Jesus. Let every satanic assembly against me be scattered.

6. Boldness and Signs:

• Lord, behold the threats of my enemies and grant me boldness to speak Your word. Stretch forth Your hand to heal and let signs and wonders be done in the name of Jesus.

7. Victory and Divine Response:

• I shall laugh last over my enemies. Lord, let my prayers arise before You and bring forth signs and wonders in my life.

Brethren, as we pray with these points, let us do so with the assurance that God is with us, and He will fight our battles. Stand firm in faith, and may the Lord grant us boldness and victory in all our endeavors. Amen.

PRAYING THE PSALMS

Beloved brethren, let us draw inspiration from the prayers of the Psalmist as we approach the throne of grace. The Psalms are rich with heartfelt cries, declarations of faith, and praises to our God. - *"The Lord hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad"* (Psalm 126:3). Mighty God, we proclaim Your victories in our lives. You have done great things for us, and we rejoice in Your goodness and mercy.
